Supporting those facing financial difficulty by contributing practical food donations.



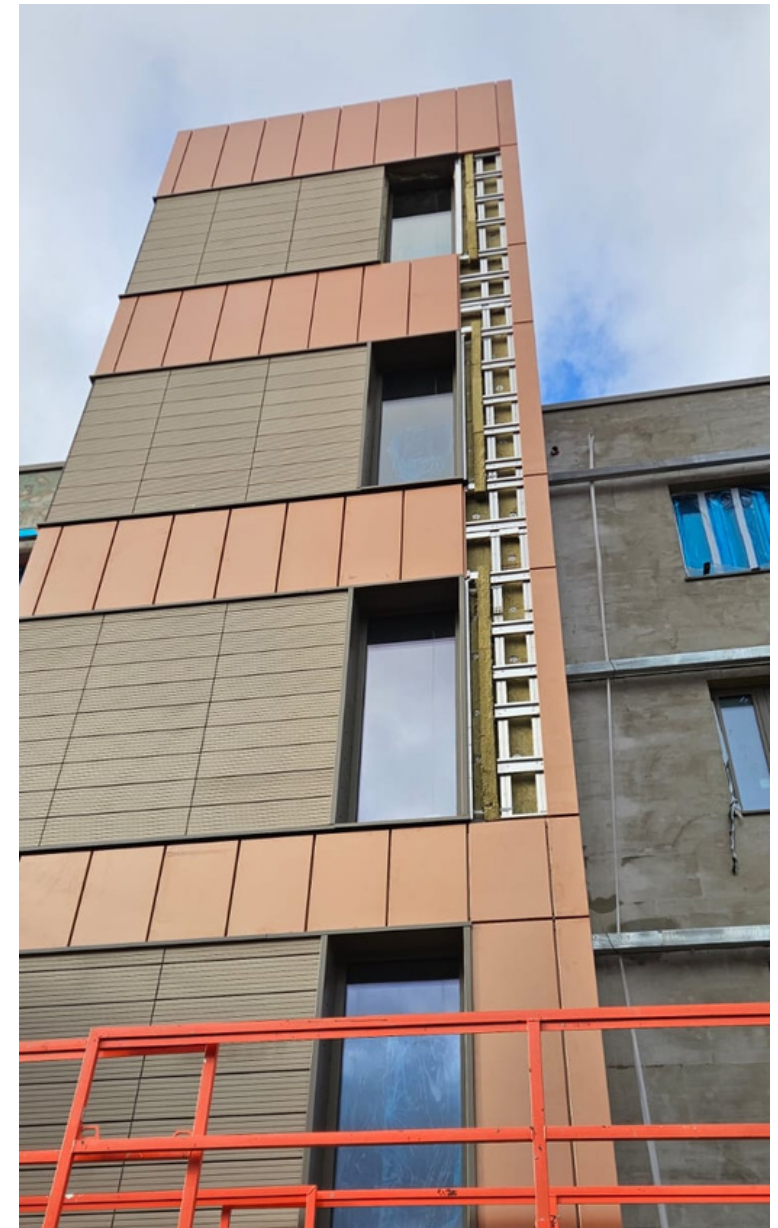
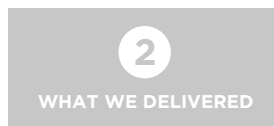
